# **COVID** Safe Regatta Measures

- 1. Club policies and the Club's Covid-19 Safety plan should be followed where applicable.
- 2. Members should exercise common sense and adhere to public health orders and social distancing requirements in place at the time and location of a particular regatta.
- 3. If in doubt over any issue, please feel free to raise it with a Committee of Management (CoM) member.

#### Specificlly:

### Health

- Should any member have any cold or flu symptoms or generally feel unwell, they must not attend. Instead, they should get COVID-19 tested and self-isolate until results are received.
- Should any member come into contact with a known source or positive COVID-19 case, they should self-isolate and advise a member of the CoM.
- Should any member have attended the same venue as a confirmed case they should get COVID-19 tested, they should self-isolate and advise a member of the CoM.

## Equipment

- Where possible, athletes should use their own equipment.
- Sculling oars that have been individually allocated by the Boat Captain should be used by members that are using club oars.
- If club allocated shared equipment is to be used, it should be thoroughly cleaned after use.
- If boats are shared, they should be cleaned thoroughly after using with the cleaning equipment located at the boat trailer.
- Regatta packing list to include cleaning equipment and hand sanitizer.

### General

- Hand sanitizer is to be available on the boat trailer.
- Practice appropriate social distancing where possible outside of the boat; 1.5 metres apart
- Avoid sharing water bottles & food.
- Adhere to any COVID-related requirements of Rowing NSW or regatta venues.
- Invoicing of athletes for seat fees to be done electronically by the Treasurer
- RNSW encourage members to use the COVIDSafe App.
